*The Interplay between idealization and authority, and the field created by the supervisee's relationship to these experiences can shape the course and outcome of clinical supervision. This year's symposium invites you to participate in a personal exploration of how the supervisor's vulnerabilities, with regard to being idealized and idealizing, impact the supervisee. Specifically, the discussion will explore how the supervisor can inhibit and/or support the supervisee's ability to internalize the supervisor's clinical skills while learning to feel and trust their own clinical authority.*

*The format of the symposium offers participants an opportunity to actively examine their personal relationship to idealization and authority. A clinically focused presentation will be followed by small group discussions aimed at exploring personal reactions to the material. The afternoon will feature a live case presentation utilizing a unique method of revealing the supervisor's and the supervisee's inner experiences as they occur during the session. The final segment of the symposium will involve small group consultations that will highlight and integrate the discussions of the day.*
